Tasks:

- Process evidence to determine the presence of latent fingerprints using any documented wet and dry laboratory process at its location.
- Processing methods include, but are not limited to, Cyanoacrylate fuming, stickyside paste, dyes, specialized lighting sources, conditions, and magnification.
- Examine the photographic image and determine whether the print has sufficient quality to make a comparison, and/or to submit to databases like the Automated Biometric Identification System (ABIS).
- Maintain chain of custody
-OR-
- Perform technical and administrative reviews
- Perform DNA analysis on collected material and physical evidence typically consisting of bodily fluids, hair, bone, dental pulp or human tissue
- Examine DNA profile suitability for matches and submission to database.
- Maintain chain of custody

Required Qualifications:

- One (1) year of experience working in a lab performing Latent Print exploitation and analysis OR one (1) year of experience performing DNA analysis on collected materials
- Able to obtain a US Secret Clearance and US Passport (those who already possess US Secret Clearance and passport preferred).
- Meet government requirements for medical fitness
- Work: Rotate between normal CONUS 40hour work schedule in Atlanta and an OCONUS work schedule up to 84 hours/week.
- Attend pre-deployment training
- Able to lift 70 lbs. to a working height of 48 inches
