- Experienced working in and complying with ISO/IEC 17025 accreditation standards.
- Experience utilizing instruments and methodologies to analyze controlled substances (e.g., Color Tests, GC, GC/MS, FTIR) and performing microscope and chemical tests.
- Experience with laboratory safety procedures, quality assurance/quality control and laboratory practices, instrumental analysis, and experience in forensic drug analysis.
- Experience or applicable training testifying in court.
- Flexibility to travel to other laboratories within the state if required.
