

New Hanover County is seeking experienced Forensic Lab professional to join the Sheriff's Office as a **Forensic Chemist** (Seized Drug/Blood Alcohol Analysis). This position is responsible for performing forensic analysis of physical evidence related to criminal investigations. Duties include conducting laboratory testing of evidence by using established procedures, methods, and databases; calibrating and testing lab equipment to ensure accuracy; documenting laboratory results and prepares written reports; testifying in court by serves as an expert witness, and preparing exhibits for courtroom use; researching and developing new lab technologies, integrating accredited lab standards and policies; and performing maintenance of equipment and instrumentation to ensure proper working order.

The New Hanover County Sheriff's Office is the principal law enforcement agency of New Hanover County, providing service to over 200,000 people within 185 square miles. The Sheriff's Office patrols the county, investigates crimes, apprehends criminals, and provides custody or control for arrested defendants, both pre-trial and sentenced.
