Job Title: Instructor/Professor of Forensic Science

Job Summary

Methodist University is seeking candidates for a full-time position to begin in August of 2021. The position may be either full time instructor or tenure track depending upon qualifications.

Responsibilities

The successful candidate will serve as an instructor or assistant professor in the Forensic Science program housed in the Department of Criminal Justice. Responsibilities will include teaching, advising, and scholarship, as well as university and community service. Topics to be taught include: Introduction to Forensic Science, Profiling, Forensic Photography, Crime Scene Investigation, Advanced Crime Scene Investigation, and similar related courses.

Special consideration will be given to applicants with experience teaching in fully online and hybrid classroom environments and to applicants with teaching and scholarly experiences that align with the Methodist University commitment to fostering equity and inclusion in all our university practices.

Applications:

Review of applications will begin immediately and continue until the position is filled. Completion of the search is dependent upon available funding at the time of hire. Qualified candidates are invited to submit a letter of intent, curriculum vitae, teaching philosophy statement, transcripts, contact information for three references, and concise equity and diversity statement about teaching or other experiences, successes, and challenges in working with a diverse student population.

Minimum Qualifications:

- A Master's Degree in Forensic Science or related field from a regionally accredited institution.
- Teaching experience and three (3) years of relevant criminal investigative and/or crime scene investigation work experience.
- Successful completion of a criminal history records check.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Doctorate in Forensic Science or other related discipline
- Five (5) + years of relevant experience
- Three (3) + years of collegiate teaching and scholarly experience
