This 8-hour, one-day course provides fire investigators, crime scene investigators, and detectives with the knowledge and practical skills necessary to effectively document fire scenes through forensic photography. Participants will learn best practices for photographing residential, vehicle, and commercial fire scenes, as well as techniques for documenting deceased individuals in fire environments.

Key Topics Include:

- Fundamentals of forensic photography (exposure, lighting, composition)
- Systematic documentation of fire scenes
- Photography of structures and vehicle fires
- Documenting fire patterns and potential origin areas
- Evidentiary photography (scales, markers, accuracy)
- Photography of human remains and thermal damage to soft tissue and bone
