



International Forensic Photography Workshop October 28 – November 01, 2019



This comprehensive, 40 hour workshop, consists of lectures and hands-on sessions designed for those in the forensic and law enforcement fields.

Participants will learn to: properly photograph an autopsy and related gross specimens, photograph a crime scene, apply basic lighting and exposure techniques, use close-up photography as a tool, freeze a bullet in motion in our high-speed photography gun range, and utilize full spectrum photography techniques to record images normally invisible to the human eye. Participants will also learn how to choose and maintain the equipment that is best suited for their needs. Each day will consist of lectures, hands-on shooting assignments followed by a review of the photographs. Camera equipment will be provided for use during the workshop, although participants are encouraged to bring their own. This workshop is approved by the IAI as professional photography training for the photography certification. This course also offers 35 credit hours of continuing education from The American Board of Medicolegal Death Investigators (ABMDI).

- Crime Scene Photography
