**Course Description:**

This 3-day hands-on course is designed for crime scene investigators, police officers, evidence technicians and other personnel who have the responsibility to properly document crime scenes and physical evidence through photography. The students will be provided with a thorough understanding of how cameras function, adjustments for various lighting conditions, proper exposure and composition, what photos to take and improve their skills as photographers. Students with limited familiarity of photography along with those who have some experience taking photos but want to improve their skills and develop a better understanding of why and how to adjust camera settings will benefit. Attendees will be able to take the camera off the automatic settings and improve images needed for investigations and court.

Instruction includes:

- Fundamentals of photography
- Understanding of basic camera operations (shutter speeds, aperture, white balance, exposure adjustments, ISO, etc)
- Automatic, program modes and manual adjustments
- Suggested camera equipment
- Crime scene and evidence photographic documentation principles
- Scene safety issues
- Lens selection
- Flash techniques
- Digital vs. Film: Pros & Cons

- How digital works
- Digital media (formats)
- Archiving digital images
- Meter usage and calculation of proper exposure
- Two & three dimensional evidence photography (footwear & tire tracks)
- Some advanced techniques including time exposure, painting with light, tips and tricks for better photos.
- Hands-on exercises
