DESCRIPTION:

Performs a variety of routine clerical, technical and administrative work in support of the investigative section of the Police Department.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

Assists in the operation of the property room that includes storage and maintenance of evidence and property and may manage the function in the absence of the Property Custodian.

Accepts, records and maintains a record system of all physical evidence and lost/found property taken into custody by the Police Department.

Disposes of evidence or lost/found property by returning it to the owner, destruction or auction, upon case clearance, in accordance with state and local rules and regulations regarding property disposition.

Conducts crime scene processing which includes recording, photographing, sketching, searching for trace evidence, latent print lifting, and collection of evidence.

Maintains crime scene supplies.

Fingerprints members of the public, when required, for various licenses or permits.

Acts as Departmental Photographer.

May be required to give testimony in court or attend depositions.

Other duties as may be assigned.

The duties listed above are intended only as illustrations of various types of work that may be performed. The omission of specific statements of duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related, or a logical assignment to the position.
