

## **Photo Contest Entry Rules**

Participants <u>must</u> include the following information on the 8.5" X 11" photo contest entry label (provided upon registration) along with their entries:

Camera Model, Lens Model, Focal Length, Filter(s), ISO, Aperture, Shutter Speed, Post Processing Techniques, etc.

## **Creative**

This category can include any subject matter relevant to the selected theme. Basic post-processing is permitted but note that the judging will be based on photographic expertise and excellence. If any post-processing is applied, you must provide a copy of the original image on your entry form and an explanation of your adjustments.

## Forensic

This category can include forensic crime scenes or evidentiary casework, research, or training photographs. Limited post-processing is permitted to demonstrate standard clarification techniques. Be sure to provide a copy of the original on your submission form along with an explanation of any post-processing efforts.
